

Installation Instructions

Requires a drill, 7/16" drill bit, and hex wrench set.



- Step 1. Place the flat surface of the Hager latch plate 3/16" (4.8mm) in from the door edge.
- Step 2. Align the latch plate vertically with the lockset.
- Step 3. With the square holes in the latch plate held to the door, use this as a guide to mark and drill two 7/16" (11.1mm) diameter holes through the door.
- Step 4. Insert two carriage bolts through the plate and secure with hex sleeve nuts from the other side of door.

Limited One Year Warranty
