

## **Edge Guard Installation Instructions**

(1) Place the edge guard over the edge of the door as shown in Figure 1.

\*The edge guard's legs are bent in slightly to fit tightly onto the door.

(2) With the edge guard lined up evenly with the top of the door mark the position of the top and bottom holes with a center punch. The use of a center punch can help center the holes so that the fasteners will enter straight.


\*A drill may be used to spot these holes while the edge guard is in place.

Note that accurate location is important for proper edge guard installation.

- (3) Remove the edge guard and drill each hole with a 3/32" bit. The accuracy of hole location is improved by drilling a smaller pilot hole first.
- (4) Attach the edge guard to the door at the top and bottom with two  $\#6 \times 3/4$  FPH tapping screw.
- (5) Drill the balance of the holes and fasten the remaining screws.
