

Rockwood Wood Door Pulls

Frequently Asked Questions

Question: What is the difference between the ArborMet series and the ArborTek series of Rockwood wood door pulls?

Answer: The ArborMet series features a wood grip with metal ends and posts. The ArborTek series features a full-length wood grip with metal only on the posts.

Question: What is the maximum wood dowel length used on wood pulls?

Answer: 48", a mid-post option is available up to 96" (This option consists of 2 wood dowels and a post with a metal sleeve in the center connecting them. When ordering, please add MP to the end of the product #).

Question: What is the maximum CTC on a 1" diameter wood pull?

Answer: 31" CTC

Question: What is Rockwood's standard wood species and wood finish?

Answer: Hickory is the standard wood species. Sanded/unfinished is the standard wood finish.

Question: Does Rockwood stain the wood pulls to match a color specified by a customer?

Answer: No, we provide a sanded/unfinished option which the customer can stain in the field.

Question: What is tung oil finish, which is offered as a finish option on wood pulls?

Answer: Tung oil finish is an extract from tung tree nuts. It is a natural drying oil that coats wood with a transparent, wet finish. It enhances the color of the wood.
